***When/Where:** Bowl on Wednesdays at 3:15pm to approximately 5:15pm at Westside Lanes in Harvey.

***Bowling Knowledge:** Knowledge or Skill in bowling is not necessary. First we bowl for fun and second we bowl to learn how to bowl. Club Bowling is a natural bridge to join the JV or Varsity Bowling Team which bowls in the Winter/Spring.

***Costs:** \$40 registration fee plus \$10.00 per week for 10-11 weeks for a total of \$140-\$150 for the season. Club Shirts are optional and their cost should not exceed \$15. Bowling shoes are for use and bowling balls are provided by Westside Lanes. Bowling shoes must be worn.

***Commitment:** Bowling is for **10 to 11 weeks in the fall**, beginning on approx. September 20, 2017, with a couple of additional tournaments on the weekends locally in Baton Rouge or Lafayette throughout the school year. Weekend tournaments are voluntary and usually require additional costs. Teams will consist of three or four members. **Club Bowling may continue into the spring for those not competing in Varsity Bowling.** Additionally, Club Bowling may also lead to a position on the JV or Varsity Bowling Team. Information concerning varsity will be given out at a later date.

***Rewards/Honor/Scholarship League Status:** **This is a youth scholarship league.** Bowlers earn scholarships while participating in the league and special tournaments through the [USBC SMART Program](#). Also, there are several out-of-town tournaments that offer scholarships for the competitors. Scholarships can add up over a four-year school career.

***Transportation:** In most cases transportation will be provided by school bus. The teams will leave school no later than 2:45pm. Bowlers riding with Mr. Chauvin will need to be picked up at the Westside Lanes by 5:30pm. Occasionally, we will not have the bus and must use the van. The van is limited to only 7 bowlers. When using the van you may need to find your own transportation to and from bowling. Mr. Chauvin will discuss this further at the first meeting.

***Practices:** Club bowlers do not usually practice as a group because of the cost involved. For startup and special tournaments Club Teams may practice (cost is about \$10.00) However, Club bowling is used as a preparation and practice ground for those students interested in bowling on the JV and Varsity Team.

***Grades:** To participate in Club Bowling you may not have 2 F's in the same quarter. School rules, Team rules, League rules, and the Coach's rules must be followed. This includes dress codes and behavior codes etc....

***College Scholarships:** The league is a Scholarship League. All prizes are given to the bowlers in the form of scholarships for college. Club Bowling and Varsity Bowling can lead to partial to full college scholarships at many colleges and universities. More information on this will be provided during bowling.
