ACADEMY OF OUR LADY RENAISSANCE

Renaissance is not a program. It's a process that encourages academic excellence, improvement, and citizenship.

Its primary goals are to increase student performance and teacher enthusiasm, and raise the level of community participation in schools.

The name "Renaissance" was chosen simply because of its definition "rebirth, renovation, refurbishment, and renewal."

Founded by educators in 1988, Jostens Renaissance is the first and only national education-focused program created to recognize and reward the academic achievements of students from elementary school through college.

Students will have the opportunity to earn a card each semester and the privileges of membership. Three levels of cards will be given based on academics, attendance, and attitude.

Students may also qualify for special recognition awards and incentives.



CARD LEVELS

GREY CARD

Standardized Test Score
3 pt. or greater increase
Absences: 3 days or less
Tardies: 3 days or less
No detentions, suspensions
or probation

BLUE CARD

Standardized Test Score
2 pt. increase
Absences: 3 days or less
Tardies: 3 days or less
No detentions, suspensions
or probation

WHITE CARD

Standardized Test Score
1 pt. increase
Absences: 3 days or less
Tardies: 3 days or less
No detentions, suspensions or
probation

HIGH FIVE AWARD

Students who significantly improve from one grading period to the next will be recognized. The "High Five" is given to those students who improve their GPA by .5 per nine weeks.

STRETCH

Special recognition and incentives will be awarded to one student from each grade level (8-12) who has "STRETCHED" her GPA the most from the previous grading period.

STUDENT/TEACHER OF THE MONTH

Each month a Student and Teacher of will be selected and presented with a certificate and small reward.

ACADEMIC RALLIES

There will be periodic special Renaissance recognition celebrations to recognize, reward, and reinforce academics and attitude. Special recognition will be given for a variety of reasons such as raising ACT scores or not receiving any minors for the quarter.
